revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God." That is what God is seeking – the yielding of our will. He wants your will brothers and sisters. He wants you to say, "Your will be done". That is what Jesus said "Your will be done Father" and that should be our hearts desire. "Your will be done in our lives". You know why your needs are not met – because His will is not being done. That is not condemnation it is where we are. We find we cannot give over to God that which is His due. He gave His life for you and I, and all we can do for Him is give Him our life in place of His life. We live in special times; it's today that we have to put right the things that are wrong. This is the time when we can yield to the Holy Spirit as His anointing flows in us. He does not expect us to make it happen. All He wants is the opportunity to work in our life anew from this moment on. It is not something you can sort out with Him and go out hoping it will all work out. It's always a present thing right now, not somewhere in the future. The Holy Spirit just wants to move in our lives now, in a new way. Invite Him now to deal with your problems and circumstances and He will.

I don't know about you but I am always trying to work things out and plan things only to find nothing ever works the way you think it will. Have you found that in your life? So many times we can be perplexed in our mind, or distressed and disturbed, but the Lord gave me something in Ph 4:7 that I think is worth passing on. It says "And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." I believe we need to guard our heart and mind and we can only do this through the power of the Holy Spirit. It says, "that passes all understanding". You see we will never understand all the things that happen to us but we have to trust and believe that God is in every circumstance and situation in our lives and have peace about that because we have got nothing to lose if we are in Him. So often God takes us in a direction that is totally opposed to where we want to go. Just think of Jesus, the turmoil He went through to go to the cross to die for our sins, but He set His face to go to Jerusalem. Sometimes we have to set our face to go the way the Holy Spirit is leading and guiding us. There is a still small voice. It is not often in the shout, it is not often in noise. The Bible says in 1 Kings 19:12, "It was in the still small voice." Within us we have this wonderful prompting of the Holy Spirit. Doug is always saying, "First thought" he doesn't mean an intellectual thought, it's something far deeper, a God given thought. God dwells deep within us He says "He is closer than a brother", why shouldn't He get the first word in. In every situation and circumstance we should expect God to speak to us first and foremost. He is in us. The thoughts that come from without are always after thoughts, things that come from intellect or external forces. God spoke right from the beginning in Genesis and then the devil came along and said "hath God said" and that is true of our daily walk with God. God says things to us then all these other thoughts come along. The devil never has an original thought: have you ever realized that. He is always responding to every situation. Are you living in that sort of atmosphere where you are responding to every situation rather than being in control through the power of God's Holy Spirit in your life. We can be in the middle of a storm and God will whisper peace, Thank God for His peace. Thank God for His patience with us. Thank God He says "I will never leave you or forsake you". Hallelujah! Wonderful Jesus! We pray God will make 2004 a special blessed year for each one of you and hope to see you very soon.

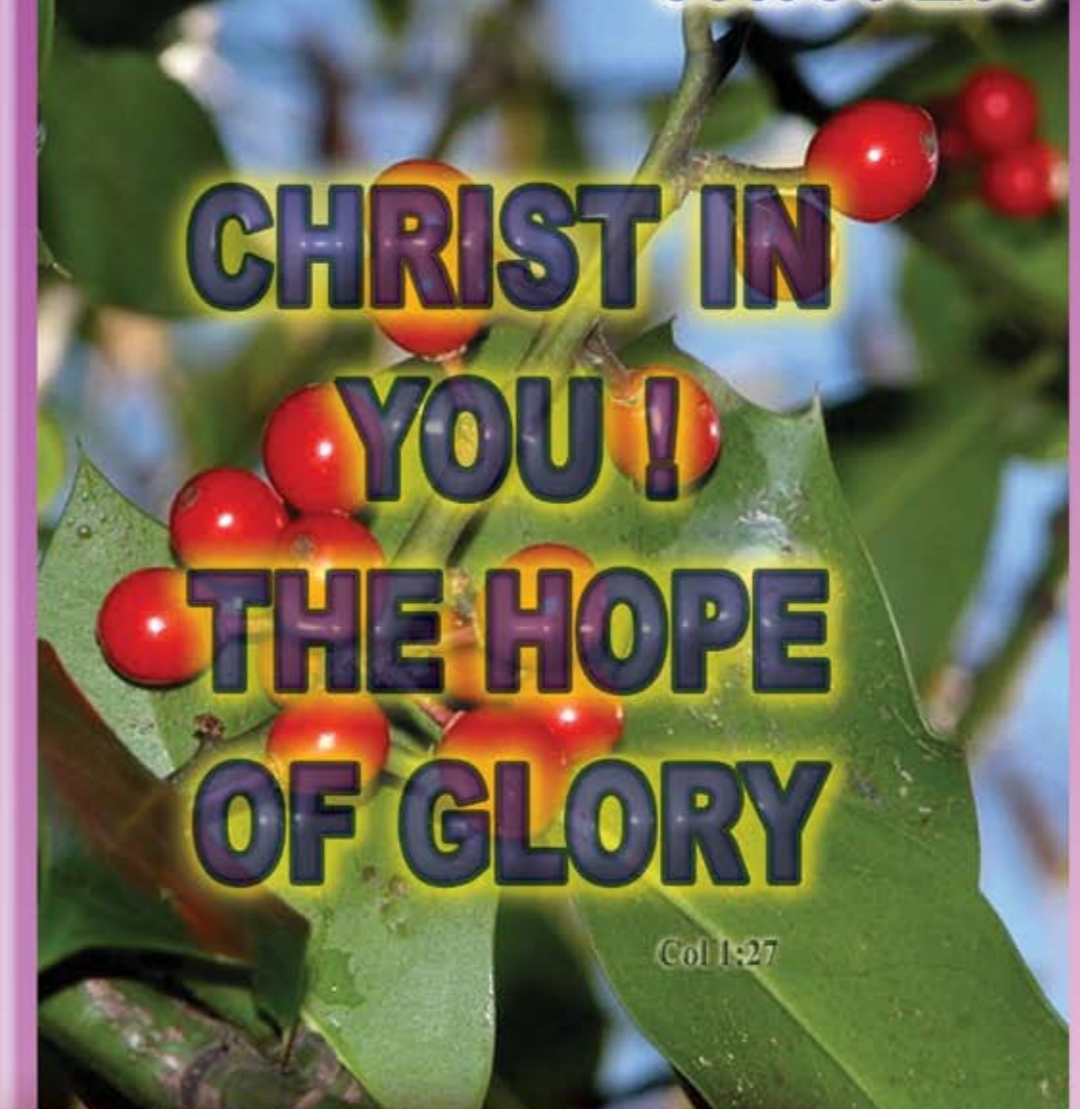

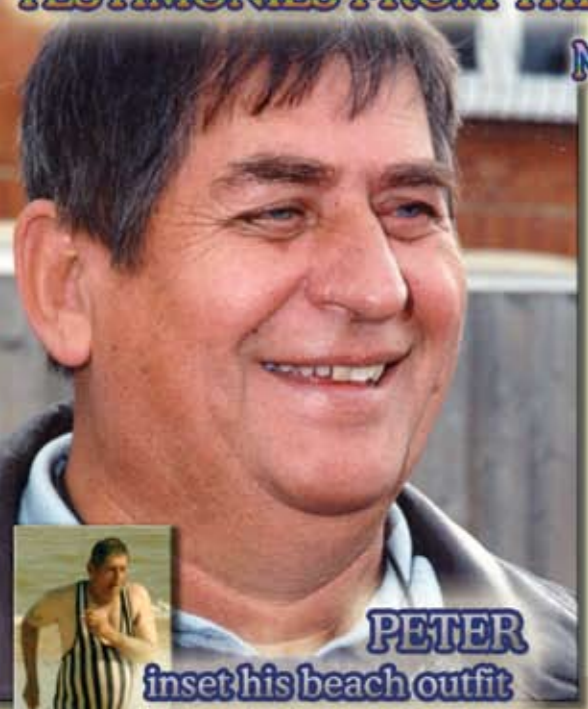

When I thought I was going to die, I did not want to. The reason that I got saved (about 20 years ago) was because I didn't want to go to hell. God has been speaking to me about liberty and I thought I knew what liberty was. I thought I could define and explain it to people but God showed me something different. In the glory meetings we talk a lot, listen a lot and sing a lot about liberty but when we get it, that is when it is real. That is when it is magnanimous in our lives. I was thinking about this and the Lord just said to me "David". So I looked at David, and in 1 Sam 17:39 it says, "And David took it off". The scripture is talking about the armour Saul had put on David when he was facing the challenge of Goliath of Gath. Saul was thinking David could not go without any protection – he could not go into the situation without some sort of protection against this giant man. David said "I can't cope with it because I know it is not what I am used to, it is not what I can handle" so he put it off and he took up his sling with his stones and off he went to face the foe. He was operating in what he knew. He was operating in what he had. God had anointed and blessed him with what he had. All his life he had been able to exist and function in what he could find on the land. He had been able to slay lions and bears in the way he knew, by God's grace.

We were hearing this week that God can use a nobody and a nothing and yet achieve everything and I am coming to understand that it is God and not us who can do what he wants according to His good pleasure. 'Glory to God'. In Genesis it says that we will make man in our image and He did, but where are we. I am a

man, you're a woman maybe, but we are made in His likeness and in His image. That means we have the capacity to hold, or to contain, the Holy Ghost. We have that capacity within this earthen vessel because we have been regenerated when the old Adam died. The second Adam became a quickening spirit. Adam was a living soul; the second Adam was a quickening spirit. The Apostle Paul grasped the secret that it was an indwelling Jesus - Jesus in us. That we are bought with a price, baptised in the Holy Ghost and have the mind of Christ. I am coming to understand, as James says, that the perfect law of liberty is hearing, accepting and doing all things spontaneously, without question, without debate, without argument. Be sure it is the Lord speaking to you, be certain you know the voice of the Lord, but this is what I believe is the perfect law of liberty - There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set me free from the law of sin and death. God's word says that, we have to believe it and accept it. There is now, not going to be, not maybe in the future sometime when we are better, there is now therefore no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus. Whom the Son sets free, is free; where the Spirit of the Lord is there is liberty. Liberty to do what? To lift up the name of Jesus! Not just in the flesh, not just with a dance. Yes, the dance is precious, it is important; it sets people free to do what God wants in their life. God's type of liberty though separates us from what is out there in the world. It separates from its pre-occupations and diversions. It separates from our old thinking and old nature. I believe rejoicing is a path or gate into the presence of God and whether you call it praise or worship does not matter a great deal to me because both come from the same source and go back to the same source. We just have to enter into whatever God is leading us into. Whether it is praise or meaningful worship, as long as He is in it, that is where I want to be.

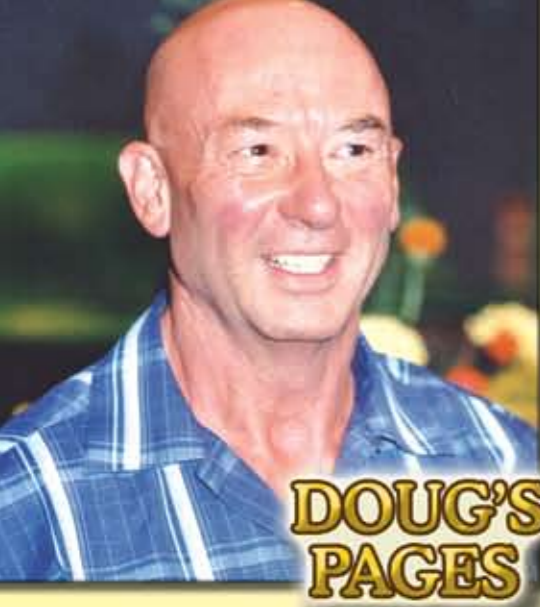
