Joshua 2:1-24 Rahab was a harlot who lived in Jericho. She hid the spies of Joshua. Because of this, the Israelites spared her life when they conquered Jericho. She later became the wife of Salmon, and the mother of Boaz.

Ruth 1:1-4:22 Ruth a foreigner from the land of Moab, her devotion was extraordinary. She left her own country to follow Naomi was married to Boaz, one of Naomi's relatives becoming the mother of Obed, the grandfather of David the King.

If you or I were organising the generations for Jesus we wouldn't have included these three : God did! Why? God is radical and He loves radical people. He chose fisherman for disciples; not the main stream religious men of His day.

God always has a way of introducing new life into any situation to up skittle men's plans and bring forth His purposes. The problem with human nature is that it becomes inward looking and exclusive needing to establish boundaries in its relationships to protect its concepts and traditions.

I believe that the downfall of the Old Covenant was its physical and spiritual inbreeding. Those who followed it carried to extreme the instructions of God not to marry the tribes in Canaan because of their pagan life style. So extreme that they didn't recognize Jesus when he was born among them! Is that happening today among the churches as revival comes I ask?

I believe that churches can get inbred and cut off so that little gets in from the outside and they start to think they are the only ones who are really walking perfectly with God. I was there once before I came into the Glory Way and I recognise it again today around me. They preach exclusivity, they control people, and they reinforce their own version of the gospel often without Jesus and His shed blood at the centre. They build a new flavour of religion with no power, without realizing that they are gradually starving themselves by excluding the Holy Spirit's input. It happens without people knowing that they have lost it and are missing being the next generation of the promise just like the Jews in the day of Jesus.

When we look particularly at the radical women in Jesus lineage we see three who were pivotal in the family of Christ who we probably wouldn't have included.

Genesis 38:6-30 Tamar was the daughter-in-law of Judah. She was a childless widow, who was given to her brother-in-law after her husband's death; he refused to give her a child so Tamar disguised herself as a harlot and seduced Judah. Through him, she became

birth a new empowered generation. In 2 Samuel 23 we read the history of David's three mighty men that God gave him to lead the army of the Lord. They were radical men called of God to bring deliverance to the nation. I believe God is likewise raising up an army of radical people today who will bring radical change to the church. The church needs a fresh input from God to bring deliverance to the current generation; I believe it is coming from outside the church yet again. David's mighty men didn't come from Saul's army, he met up with them in the cave of Adullam when he was being persecuted. Persecution usually comes from dead religion so be ready to be criticised as not everyone will be overjoyed to see a fresh move of God, as it's too challenging for some. It certainly messes up church when you are trampling on many sacred cows.

I have had the privilege of living through at least three moves of God and we are seeing the start of a fourth. Radical things are happening right now, God is birthing a new generation. The secret of revival in the church is to be brave enough to let God bring a radical element in to mess up the traditions of the last move, and then new life flows out to reach others. The church needs God's radical input over and over to produce a fresh harvest of souls.

As you will see from the center pages God is birthing a radical group of people in the Basildon street outreach just like He did with Henri in Mansfield Market in the 1950's. There's real excitement that God is moving again among us outside the church it brings a real buzz back into the church, when we see the hand of God outside on the street.

Jesus came as an outsider. If we don't let His Radical presence feature in the everyday life of the church we are missing the true power that Revival can bring. So like Jesus let us get outside the camp and reach out to the lost in these the end times, who knows this could be the move of God that ushers in the return of Jesus.

Father we pray that you will give us the grace to allow our lives to be radicalised for you in the coming days as you pour out your spirit again on the church in this coming year". Amen

GOD'S LIGHT IN OUR HEARTS

I was reading 2 Corinthians chapter 4 and it really came alive to me so I want to share my thoughts with you too.

Verse 6 tells us that "it was God who commanded light to shine out of the darkness and who has shone into our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the Glory of God in the face of Jesus". It was no mistake when the Lord caused His light to shine into the darkness of our own hearts and illuminate Jesus to us, to make Him known to us. The revelation of the truth in our hearts points us to see the Glory of God in the face of Jesus. You might also remember the priestly blessing in Num 6 with which Moses instructed Aaron to bless the Children of Israel "May the Lord bless you and keep you and make His Face to shine upon you and be gracious to you, the Lord lift His countenance upon you and give you peace". Jesus himself, the Great High Priest is carrying out that blessing to us today to those who are willing to receive Him. 1 Chron 11:16 Encourages us to "Seek the LORD and His strength, seek His face evermore", there is more to go for. It's not just a one-time experience, there's ongoing revelation of the Glory of God. An old chorus we sometimes sing is so fitting to this passage: 'turn your eyes upon Jesus, look full in His wonderful face, and the things of the earth will grow strangely dim, in the light of His glory and grace'.

Verse 10-11 "always carrying about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body. For we who live are always delivered to death for Jesus' sake, that the life of Jesus may also be manifested in our mortal flesh". The flesh life is continually being killed off, but the inward man is being renewed day by day. Praise God, more of Him and less of me. Life more abundantly and Jesus being seen in us! Paul says in Phil 3:10 "that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death". He desires to personally experience the resurrection power of God and suggests it takes the experience of death to bring that about. The flesh is at enmity to God so has to go.

Verse 12-15 "So then death is working in us, but life in you" "knowing that He who raised up the Lord Jesus will also raise us up with Jesus, and will present us with you. For all things are for your sakes, that grace, having spread through the many, may cause thanksgiving to abound to the glory of God". Paul is saying that death is working in them (him and the brothers with him) that life might be brought



about in those they minister Jesus to. This is God's way of bringing others to the knowledge of Himself and to experience His grace, a divine principle. He says in John 12:24 that "unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains alone, but if it dies it produces much grain". Jesus Himself demonstrated this principle in His own death that by it we might be made spiritually alive and have eternal life, and we die that we and others might live, and that God might be glorified.

Verse 16 "Therefore we do not lose heart, even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day". This verse is such an encouragement to me to know that life is being renewed on a daily basis, so yesterday's life does not have to be enough for today. Oh the grace of God and how he knows our needs. We are not the finished article, we are being perfected. We are killing off the carnal nature, putting to death the deeds of the flesh, subduing wrong desires etc, meanwhile, the life in us which is being renewed everyday is sustaining us, changing us, revealing more of the Glory of God to us and reproducing itself in the lives of others. It's powerful stuff and I think we're probably oblivious to a lot of the work that is being undertaken in us and through us but verse 18 says it's eternal. "While we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen, for the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal"

So let's thank God that he ever caused His light to illuminate the darkness in our hearts and caused us to look unto Jesus. Not only that but that He has not finished His work in us, death and life are at work simultaneously to perfect us and make us a fitting bride.

TOUCHED BY GOD'S LOVE

My name is Nelma De Assis and I'm 19 years old. God is so wonderful and He has done so much for me over these few months. Let me take you a few years back in my life, I grew up as a Christian all my life and I've always been in a Christian environment. I've been involved in a number of churches over the years but I never felt the love from the people. It took me years to make any friends and the only way I made friends was by getting involved in the media side of things but outside of church, I was smoking and drinking and getting into a bad group of friends. My parents got very upset once when I told them that God was not real. I had prayed 'the sinners prayer' a number of times, but I thought it was just something that I had to do to keep people happy. It got so bad that in 2009, I left College in a mess.

We then started attending Noak Bridge earlier this year and I knew it was different. The moment I stepped into the hall, I could feel the love of God – this didn't stop me from thinking that the service was very long and boring. A few weeks on, I went along with my dad to a prayer meeting prior to a Church on the Street event. I could see all the people praising and leaping about and praying and I was completely shocked and freaked out by it all. I sat there my usual bored self, but then Matt came up and asked if he could pray for me....the next thing I know, I had a warm feeling inside me when he prayed.

Five minutes later, a lady started speaking over my life about how I am a leader and not a follower, and this caused me to cry inside. She picked up her Bible and there was a part of me not wanting it, as I could feel the pain inside. Inside me I started to cry, and I was trying so hard to not let any tears come out of my eyes but before I could control it, I started to cry openly and all the pain that I felt inside me was being released. I didn't know what was going on inside me.

She continued to speak to me in depth about God's love. She then turned to me and asked me "Do you want to give your life to God?" and I just knew that question was coming, but this time I was really ready to give my life to God, from deep down in my heart. That night I gave my life to God afresh and I just cried out, all the pain I felt inside for so many



years of my life. The next day was "Church on the Street" and I was there as well, standing for God while I was on the streets. I was just praising God and giving thanks to God for everyone. I even got on the platform to give my life testimony that day, spoke about "how I got married to God again".

As we were on the street, I noticed a young lady walking pass us and I was just drawn to her to just say "God loves you". The next thing I knew, she started to cry and then I turned to her said "give me a hug" and although she was refusing my hug, I gave her one as I could see she needed it. Then we got to talk a bit more, to my surprise she started to open up with me and she said to me that she was originally going home that day to commit suicide. She then turned round to me and said "you have made my day, in fact my week". I was so grateful to be a part of the team that day. I felt very touched and moved, just by what I saw that young lady do and it showed me that I can make a difference just by saying "GOD LOVES YOU"

From Flatulence to Fruitfulness

Isaiah 26:18.(the message)

We were pregnant full term,
We writhed in labour but bore no baby.
We gave birth to wind.
Nothing came of our labour,
We produced nothing living,
We couldn't save the World.

Sometimes all of our planning all of effort all of our hopes, all that we try to do comes to nothing. In fact it's worse than nothing; for want of a polite word, it's all just flatulence,

a bad smell. No baby and No end result. We can't Save the World. We want to see people saved and lives changed but we just end up breaking wind (hey don't have a go at me it's how the book describes it talk to the author if you have a problem.)

Well I'll be honest I have felt like that lots of times. Recently, however, the Lord has done the very opposite - he has surprised us. He has shown up with the suddenly and births have just started to happen before we were prepared. Babies just popping out! We are called to be His midwives; delivering His children into the kingdom. When Beth gave birth to our daughter: Faith in September the maternity ward closed after we got in as it was so busy. There have been many times when it has been closed; the expectant mothers have often given birth in cars on the way to somewhere else. Likewise there will be times when we can't wait for church to be open but someone will be ready to become born again on the way to church. God is without limits and wants to do what He wants to do.

Recently we saw Nelma saved, giving her life back to Jesus in the COTS prayer meeting on the Friday night. She then came out with us and radically preached on the street. And do you know what? She out-preached us all. She was, and is, truly amazing. What a surprise in the prayer meeting for souls, brought along by her dad, sitting at the back, trying to hide! The Holy Ghost set her and us all up, good and proper - lol. That was one of the best prayer meetings I have ever been to. We all rejoiced and jumped about (it was a special night).

Last Saturday I brought a minibus down from Norwich. I brought Scottish John (a man who loves winning souls) and he said his unsaved nephew was staying with him and could he come. I said not really because we were doing evangelism but reluctantly agreed thinking he could come for the ride and do something else (as I am a bit slow sometimes).

Well on the way I started talking to him about the Lord as you do, and before long we pulled the van over and right there in a rusty van that has done 250,000 miles at about 10:00 in the morning on the A12 he became born again. He got it real and you know within a couple of hours, he put on a Church on the Street hoodie and came out witnessing. I was overwhelmed. What's that all about? Well you know Jesus can do what He wants to - it's His Church On The Street. He can save them whenever and wherever - I don't care, just save them Lord. That night John Wilkinson prayed for this lad, Anderson and he was soon on the floor under the Glory. In Church on Sunday, 36 hours after being born, he testified of what the Lord had done in his life. He then was dancing at the front completely full of the Lord, clean and brand new. You could even see the change

on his face. Let me tell you in this end time, the Lord is going to do a quick work and there will be many new converts taken from the street that will overtake those that have been saved (doing nothing in their comfy pews) for decades. All the Glory to Jesus. Do it again and again! On the streets we have been asking the Lord for the discernment of spirits and the Word of Knowledge and we have seen it. Many times a word has been given and people have wept because they know only God could have known that. We have had words about sexual abuse, unforgiveness, despair depression, being in prison, to name a few.

One recent example is that I went to talk to these Sea Scouts, who were collecting money for something or other. The Holy Ghost told me to give them some money and I thought why should I (again I am a bit slow). I gave them something and then invited them to collect money near us so they could hear the message. The mighty David Shipman started preaching and he had a word of knowledge about a back and right knee. Suddenly a Sea Scout came to me and said that's my friend - he's got a bad back and a painful right leg. Well I took the amazing Shippo with me to the excited Sea Scout and we prayed for him and instantly his friend was healed of both. He was shocked. I then gave them the gospel and it was easy for them both to give their lives to Jesus. Praise the Lord.

Never underestimate the power of a single word you might get for someone. Sometimes (like the woman at the well with Jesus) it is the key that unlocks their Salvation. Church on the Street was birthed in Basildon and I believe it will go across the country. This is the time for the end time harvest. Will you join us...?

Sons of Thunder

Today the Lord spoke to me and asked me to raise up 100 End Time Champions across this country. Radicals for Jesus. Men who I can mentor, encourage, pray with and speak deep into their lives. Men sold out for Jesus who want to grow in the calling and giftings put in them.
